

Quarantine and Isolation Guidance (August 2022)



This revised guidance outlines that quarantine is no longer routinely recommended for asymptomatic individuals after exposure to COVID-19 infected individuals.

	Tested Positive (Regardless of vaccination status)	Asymptomatic and Exposed (Regardless of vaccination status)
Students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Begin isolation at home and undergo testing as recommended by their healthcare provider ● Contact your school immediately ● Day 0 is day the symptoms began ● Isolate for 5 calendar days ● May return after Day 5 if asymptomatic or symptoms are resolved and fever-free for 24 hours. ● Encouraged to wear a mask Days 6-10, but not required 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Do not have to be quarantined. ● May stay in school as long as they remain asymptomatic <p>*Every school nurse clinic has masks available</p>
School Staff	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Begin isolation at home and undergo testing as recommended by their healthcare provider ● Contact your school administrator immediately ● Day 0 is day the symptoms began ● Isolate for 5 calendar days ● May return after Day 5 if asymptomatic or symptoms are resolved and fever-free for 24 hours. ● Required to wear a mask Days 6-10, unless medical documentation of an exemption is on file from healthcare provider. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Do not have to be quarantined. ● May stay in school as long as they remain asymptomatic <p>*Every school nurse clinic has masks and tests available</p>
