When to Quarantine After Exposure to a Case of COVID-19



Student or Staff Tests Positive (Isolation for 10 days) **Isolation** = an individual diagnosed with COVID-19 is separated from others for 10 days.

Exposed = being within 6 feet of a person diagnosed with COVID-19 for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more throughout a 24-hour period starting from two days before illness onset (or, for asymptomatic patients, the day of test specimen collection). Individuals within 3-6 feet of an individual diagnosed with COVID-19 in an indoor setting are not considered close contacts if **BOTH** individuals are correctly and consistently wearing masks the entire time. Quarantine requires 14 days for possible development of virus.

Masked Appropriately = wearing a CDC approved mask consistently and correctly.
