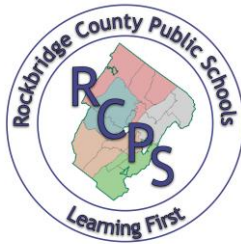

Rockbridge County School Board Approves Renaming the Athletic Stadium Complex at Rockbridge County High School to “Prasnicki-Ross Field at Veterans Stadium”

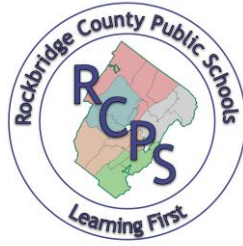
Lexington, VA – The Rockbridge County School Board voted unanimously at its regular monthly meeting on March 10, 2020 to at a ceremony in the future to rename the Rockbridge County High School Football Stadium to the **Prasnicki-Ross Field at Veterans Stadium**.

Rockbridge County Public Schools Division Superintendent, Phillip Thompson made a request for this action from the school board. Dr. Thompson stated, *“I grew up in Rockbridge County and am a proud product of our school division. I started my teaching career here and I have been fortunate to spend much of my career in my home of Rockbridge County. Unfortunately, in all my time I have spent here, I never had the opportunity to meet Stephen (Chase) Prasnicki, nor did I meet Andrew Ross.*

Both of these gentlemen grew up here in Rockbridge County, both attended Central Elementary School, Maury River Middle School, and Rockbridge County High School. While growing up here, people who knew them shared with me that they were model citizens, leaders, scholars, star athletes, and while a year separated them in school, they were close friends.

Upon graduation from RCHS, they both chose to attend the United States Military Academy at West Point. Upon graduation from West Point, they both served in combat units of the US Army, and unfortunately, both paid the ultimate sacrifice in defense of our country.
