	Order your cap & gown for Graduation - you MUST have one to participate and prices go up on December 1.
	Register for and take the SAT/ACT again if needed
	Complete and turn in your Blue Sheet, Brag Sheet, & FERPA form to the counseling office
	Arrange for any letters of recommendation from your counselor and teachers
	Attend the College Fair at RCHS (September)
	Complete any Early Action or Early Decision applications (Common App)
	Scholarships - start applying! National ones have deadlines as early as September and October

	Look for correspondence from colleges and universities you applied to
