

The Discipline Committee of the Rockbridge County School Board held a special meeting on Tuesday, October 16, 2018 at the Rockbridge County School Board Office.

Present: Trustees Corey Berkstresser, Heather Hostetter, and Wendy Lovell; Haywood Hand, Assistant Superintendent.

CALL TO ORDER:

Trustee Lovell called the meeting to order at 4:41 p.m.

Under Section 2.2-3711.A (2) of the State Code, Trustee Hostetter recommended that the Board go into a *Closed Meeting* to discuss one student discipline matter. Motion was made by Trustee Hostetter, seconded by Trustee Berkstresser, and passed by 3-0 vote.

The Board entered into the *Closed Meeting* at 4:42 p.m.

The Board returned to open session at 5:52 p.m.

Trustee Berkstresser read the following motion to Certify the Closed Meeting:

WHEREAS, the Rockbridge County School Board has convened a closed meeting on this date pursuant to an affirmative recorded vote and in accordance with the provisions of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.2-3712.D of the Code of Virginia requires a certification by this School Board that such closed meeting was conducted in conformity with Virginia law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rockbridge County School Board hereby certifies that, to the best of each member's knowledge, (i) only public business matters lawfully exempted by Virginia law were discussed in the closed meeting to which this certification applies, and (ii) only such public business matters as were identified in the motion convening the closed meeting were heard, discussed or considered.

Upon initial motion of Certification of Closed Meeting by Trustee Berkstresser, and seconded by Trustee Hostetter, the motion passed by the following roll call vote:

Trustee Lovell - Aye
Trustee Berkstresser - Aye

Upon motion by Trustee Hostetter, seconded by Trustee Berkstresser, and passed by unanimous vote, the following action was taken regarding student case number 1819-100-10 as a result of a violation of the student code of conduct.

1. Student may return to Rockbridge County High School on Friday, October 19, 2018 at the end of ten-day suspension.
2. Student will be on social probation through January 6, 2019. Student is not allowed to attend or participate in any extracurricular activities at Rockbridge County High School. Additionally, student is prohibited from attending any activities on other schools' property in which Rockbridge County Public Schools is participating.
